- Have each teen and tween present practice their Pig Latin by writing a short story in the language, than swap stories with another participant and the first person to translate the story (less than a page) will get a prize!

#### **Find the PIGS Scavenger Hunt:**

After you have done the Pig Latin Class, now it's time to put your new found language to use! Hold a pig scavenger hunt with the clues entirely in Pig Latin!

- Hide Pig Cut-outs around your library (or teen area if you have a designated space).
- Using clues to the location of the pigs, teens and tweens must locate each pig and write down where they found the pig.
- Examples of some clues:
  1. Indfay isthay igpay inway erewhay ilighttway ancay ebay oundfay
  2. Isthay extnay ig'spay omehay isway erewhay youway entway orfay orytime stay asway away ildchay
