

Creative Craft Stick Projects

Napkin Rings

Materials

- Felt
- Popsicle sticks
- Tacky glue
- Small paintbrush
- Buttons in assorted colors

Instructions

1. For each napkin ring, cut a 4- by 5 1/2-inch piece of felt. Starting at one short end of the rectangle, glue on 12 Popsicle sticks, lining them up side by side. You should end up with a margin of uncovered felt at the end.
2. Once the glue dries, form a ring by gluing the overlapped felt together
3. Now comes the fun part: glue on rows of buttons. Let the glue dry completely.



Popsicle Lantern

Materials

- Popsicle Sticks
- Assorted wooden shapes
- Wax Paper
- Scissors
- Tacky Glue
- Faux tea light candles

Instructions

1. Lay a 24" piece of wax paper on your work surface. Start at the left bottom and glue four craft sticks on the wax paper to make a box.
2. Right next to it make another box of four craft sticks. Repeat two more times so you have four boxes.
3. Arrange wooden shapes in each box to make an attractive design. Glue in place. Let dry.
4. Trim the wax paper along the top. Trim down the side but leave a half inch to glue. Fold wax paper to make a box. Glue flap to secure.
5. Set a candle in a votive inside and see how pretty it looks when the light shines through.
